Gina getting behind Trump

THE Territory's largest private landholder has praised the policies of US President-elect Donald Trump.

Gina Rinehart urged the Turnbull Government to adopt similar policies during a speech to the National Mining and Related Industries Day. Australia's richest woman recently visited Washington meeting key members of Trump's campaign team including former New York

mayor Rudy Giuliani and campaign manager Kellyanne Conway. Mrs Rinehart said Mr Trump's commitment to less government tape and cutting company tax to 15 per cent were two positive policies.
